

Information for Customers (for the distribution within the European Union)

Material Safety Data Sheet for Aspartame, Sodium Cyclamate, Saccharin (550-times) and Sodium Saccharin

The above mentioned products are **no** dangerous substances according to Article 2 (2) of the Council Directive 67/548/EEC of 27 June 1967 on the approximation of laws, regulations and administrative provisions relating to the classification, packaging and labelling of dangerous substances, in its last amended version.

The specific provisions relating to labelling laid down in the Council Directive 67/548/EEC and Council Directive 88/379/EEC of 7 June 1988 on the approximation of laws, regulations and administrative provisions of the Member States relating to the classification, packaging and labelling of dangerous substances do **not** apply to the above mentioned sweeteners.

Therefore it is **not** necessary to supply a material safety data sheet for above named sweeteners as mentioned in the Commission Directive 91/155/ECC of 5 March 1991 defining and laying down the detailed arrangements for the system of specific information relating to dangerous preparations in implementation of article 10 of Directive 88/379/EEC.

Specific precautionary measures for this group of sweeteners in order to avoid danger must **not** been taken.

When disposing soiled remaining stock please do follow the current regulations of water protection (at federal, regional state and local level).
